

ORDINACNE NO. 82-3

Entitled an Ordinance Annex in the hereinafter described territory of the City of Newton, Newton County, Texas, and extending the boundary limits of said City as to include the said hereinafter described property within the City Limits, and granting the said Territory and to all future inhabitants of said property all of the rights and privileges of other citizens and binding said future inhabitants by all of the acts and ordinances of said City.

WHEREAS, two (2) public hearings were held concerning the proposed annexation of the territory described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto for all purposes, with one such hearing held within the area proposed to be annexed. At both such public hearings, all interested persons were provided an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, such public hearings were held not more than forty (40) days nor less than twenty (20) days prior to the institution or annexation proceedings; and,

WHEREAS, notices of such public hearings were published in the newspaper having general circulation in the City of Newton, Texas, not more than twenty (20) nor less than ten (10) days prior to such hearing, and,

WHEREAS, the territory lies adjacent to and adjoins the present boundaries of the city of Newton, Texas;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT
ORDAINED BY THE
CITY OF NEWTON:**

SECTION 1.

The land and territory lying adjacent to and adjoining the present boundaries of the City of Newton, Texas and depicted on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes, is hereby added and annexed to the City of Newton, Texas and said territory hereinafter described shall hereinafter be included within the boundary limits of such City at the Various points contiguous to the area hereinafter depicted in Exhibit "A", are altered and amended as to include said area within the corporate limits of the City of Newton, Texas.

SECTION 2.

The described territory in the area so annexed shall be a part of the City of Newton, Texas, and the inhabitants thereof, if any, shall be entitled to all the rights

and privileges of all the citizens and shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, resolutions, and regulations of the City of Newton, Texas.

SECTION 3.

The Service Plan for such annexed area attached hereto as “Exhibit “B” is hereby approved.
