

ORDINANCE 02-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEWTON TEXAS REGULATING THE SPEED DURING THE REHABILITATION PROJECT SCHEDULED FOR AUGUST 2002 FOR STATE MAINTAINED HIGHWAY US 190 FROM BACON STREET TO CANEY CREEK IN THE CITY OF NEWTON, NEWTON COUNTY, TEXAS PROVIDING A PENALTY AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWTON, TEXAS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I - REGULATING SPEED ON STATE MAINTAINED HIGHWAYS:

The maximum legal speed limits of all vehicles in the city limits of Newton in the following highways shall be set forth in each zone as shown in the list below. The construction speed zone will terminate upon completion of project and then return to established speed zone previously set by ordinance 00-8.

HIGHWAY	SPEED LIMIT
US 190	35 MPH
Bacon St. to Caney Creek	

SECTION II - PENALTY:

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance or who shall neglect to comply with the terms hereof shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall on conviction thereof be fined in any sum or not less than \$85.00 and not more than \$362.20.

SECTION III – REPEALING CLAUSE:

Any and ordinances of the City of Newton, Texas in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.
