

ORDINANCE 99-01

REGULATING THE SPEED ON STATE MAINTAINED HIGHWAYS FM 1012 IN THE CITY OF NEWTON, NEWTON COUNTY, TEXAS PROVIDING A PENALTY AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF NEWTON, NEWTON COUNTY, TEXAS.

SECTION I – REGULATING THE SPEED ON STATE MAINTAINED HIGHWAYS: The maximum legal speed limits of all vehicles in the city limits of Newton on the following highways shall be as set forth in each zone as shown on the Attached Seed Zone Map, based on eighty-five percentile speed, and traffic and engineering investigations made by the Texas Department of Transportation. Said Speed Zone Strip Map is hereby made a part of this Ordinance and is as follows:

HIGHWAY: FM 1012 SURVEY DATE: 08-13-98

SECTION II – PENALTY: Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance or who shall neglect to comply with the terms hereof shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall on conviction thereof be fined in any sum of not less than \$85.00 and not more than \$200.00 and the violation of the posted maximum speed in each zone on the Speed Zone Map and each time each maximum speed in each zone is violated, constitutes a separate offense.

SECTION III – REPEALING CLAUSE: Any and all Ordinances of the city of Newton in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.
