

RESOLUTION AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 81-6

The following resolution shall be added to Shall be added to Schedule 147 of Ordinance No. 81-6 passed by the City of Newton, Texas on May 28, 1981.

The following switchover policy shall apply:

In cases where electric service is being provided to a consumer by City of Newton, Texas and said consumer requests disconnection of electric service in order to obtain electric service from another utility certified to the area, the following rules shall apply:

1. The consumer shall request in writing to the City of Newton the disconnection of electric service from the desired location.
2. The consumer shall pay the following charges prior to disconnection:
 - a) A charge of 188.34 to cover average direct labor and transportation costs involved in the disconnection.
 - b) A charge for distribution facilities rendered idle as a result of the disconnection and not useable elsewhere on the system based on the original cost of such facilities less accumulated depreciation, salvage, and any previous contribution in aid of construction.
 - c) A charge for the direct and indirect labor and transportation costs involved in removing any idle facilities. This charge will only apply if removal is requested by the disconnecting consumer, required for safety reasons or if the salvage value of the facilities exceeds such removal costs.
 - d) All charges for electric service up to the date of disconnection.
3. Upon payment of the above charges, the consumer shall receive a paid receipt from the City of Newton for presentation to the connection utility. In accordance with the Public Utility Commission of Texas Substantive Rule 052.02.04.048(b), the consumer shall be advised that the connecting electric utility may not provide service to said consumer until such connecting utility has evidence that the consumer has paid all charges provided for under this ordinance.
